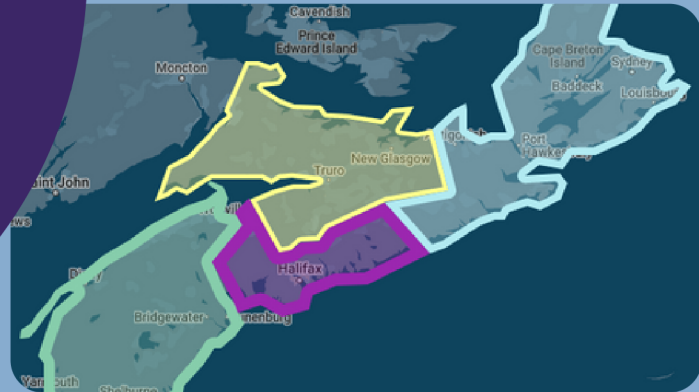


# Follow-up HIV testing services

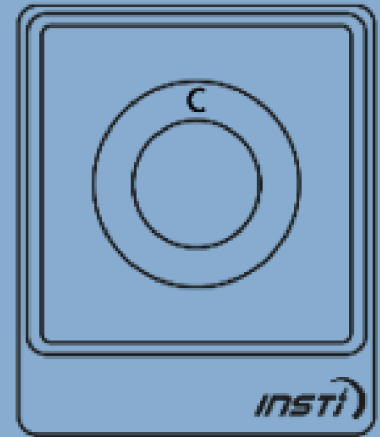
